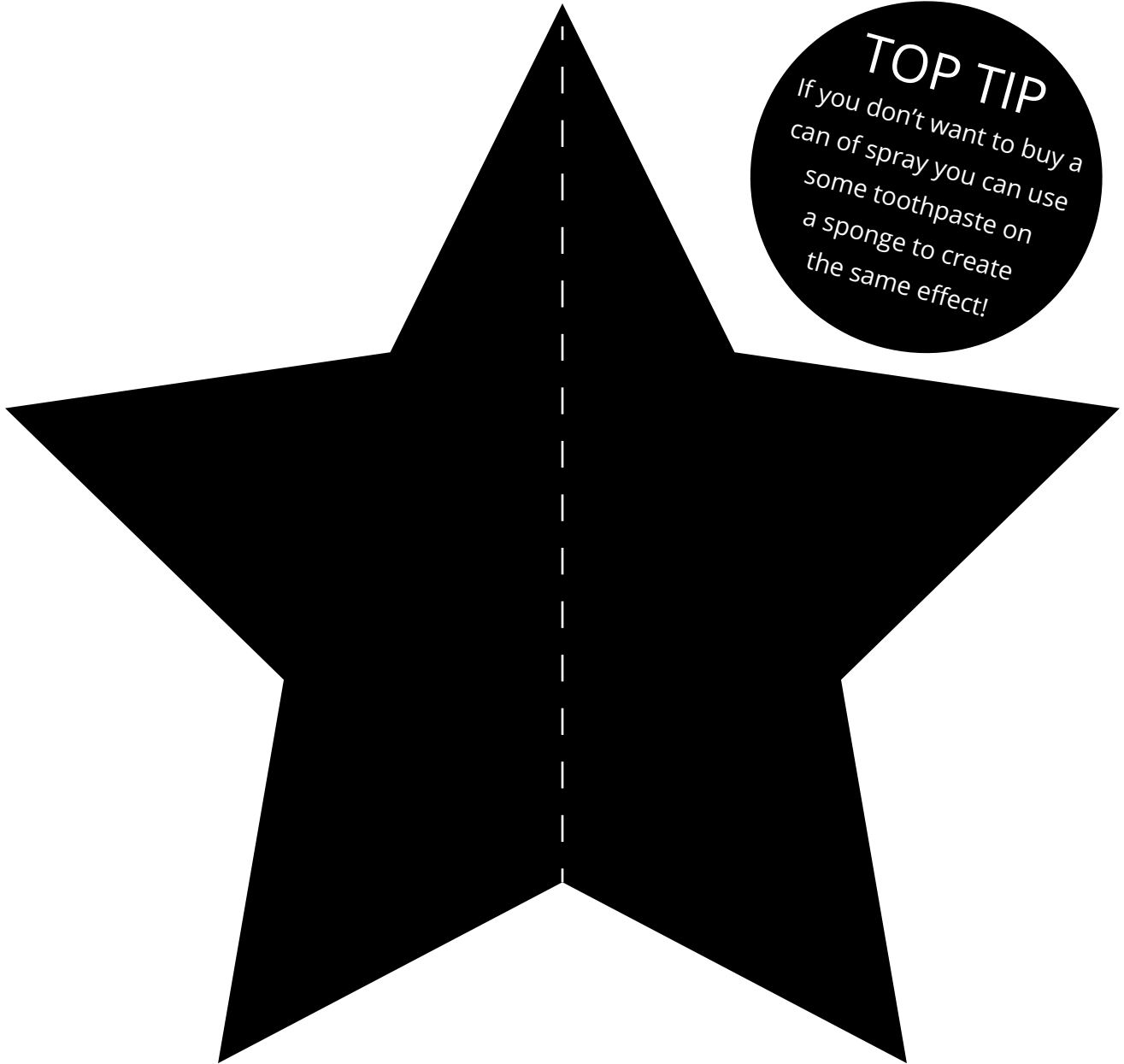


It's Christmas and it is time to adorn your windows and doors
with snow frosted stencil decorations



TOP TIP
If you don't want to buy a
can of spray you can use
some toothpaste on
a sponge to create
the same effect!

Instructions

- 1) Prepare your window by cleaning it thoroughly and laying newspaper down to protect the surfaces below.
- 2) Print your chosen stencil sheet on to light weight card. 3) Fold along the dotted line. 4) Cut out black areas (Parents must help younger children cut out stencils).
- 5) Use masking tape or gel stickers to secure the stencil on the inside of your window glass.
- 6) You can spray the shapes using a can of spray snow following the instructions on the can.
- 7) Remove the pieces of gel stickers or masking tape. 8) Gently peel away the stencil sheet and you'll see the objects appear.
- 9) When spraying and you accidentally go over the stencil, you can clean with a damp cloth.
